

Health Protocol – Jardy Eventing Show 9th – 14th July 2020

You will find below all the informations about the health protocol for the competition and the organisation of the Jardy Eventing Show. It's important to read it in detail and to apply it carefully.

The barrier gestures apply on the whole site, it's everyone's responsibility to respect the health protocol established for the security of one and all.

Arrival & Access times to the site

The parking will be accessible only on the following schedule:

- Wednesday 8 July between 10 am and 9 pm
- Thursday 9 July between 7 am and 9 pm
- Friday 10 July between 7 am and 9 pm
- Saturday 11 July between 6 am and 9 pm
- Sunday 12 July between 6 am and 9 pm

In the view of the measures planned by the prefecture, **no times exemption could be granted**. Lorries arriving outside that time won't be able to access to the site. We would like to draw your attention on the fact that this schedule must be respected, especially on the arrival days with strong influence (Wednesday and Thursday).

Organisation of parkings

Considering the organisation of the parking, lorries will be parked by the international standard. No camping, no terrace, no awning could be deployed to keep most of the space.

Electricity is free, it's responsibility of anyone to unroll correctly the power extension rolls, to not overload electrical outlets and to restrain to the maximum its consumption.

- **Heavy vehicle's parking** : a specific parking will be in place for cars . A signposting and agents will indicate you the process.

Please respect all the instructions given by the staff on site.

Passports & Horses' control

Riders of CCI2*L : the horses passports must be dropped of at the rider office at the latest an hour before the vet inspection.

For the other classes, a horse control will be done at the stables with the horses passports given to the organisation. **Thank you to do it at your arrival.**

Access to the competition

Considering the health recommendations linked to the organisation of sports events, the access to the competition (arenas, cross country, stables and catering area) will be reserved to:

- Riders of the competition
- Owners and grooms
- Trainors and coaches

The access to the competition zone will be conditioned with the wearing of a wristband. The wristbands must be collected at the event's reception.

It's up to each rider to make their requests for their owners, grooms and others accompanying.

Temperature's check

According to the FEI's protocol, riders, owners, grooms and accompanying must report : every morning before 12 am and every evening before 12 pm their temperature via a dedicate form. Link available on our web site.

Competition officials will check their report before the beginning of every event for the concerned riders.

Catering

The Orangerie, catering area, is strictly reserved to the riders, grooms, owners and accompanying with wristbands. People without wristbands will not be able to access there.

Hands disinfection is compulsory at the entrance, as well as wearing a mask. Dogs are prohibited in the catering area.

Sport practice

Considering the sport practice: application of the FFE's and FEI's health protocols throughout the site.
